

# **Privacy Policy for the volunteers and activists of the Civilek Józsefvárosért Association and András Pikó**

Effective: from 1 February 2024

The purpose of this Privacy Notice is to inform the data subjects about the processing of personal data of activists by the C8 - Civilek Józsefvárosért Association and András Pikó as joint data controllers.

## **1. Identification of the joint controllers**

The joint data controllers designate the Civilek Józsefvárosért Association as the data controller for the contact related to the data processing activities.

## **2. Legislation on data processing**

Your data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Regulation (EC) No 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter: GDPR) and Act CXII of 2011 on the Right to Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information (Infotv.).

## **3. Data processing activities related to the political activities of the Mayor**

### **3.1. Scope of the data processed and purpose of the processing**

According to Article 9(1) of the GDPR, political opinions are special categories of data, the processing of which is more limited in scope and subject to more stringent safeguards than other data processing. As the personal data of data subjects are almost always linked to these

special categories of data in the context of the processing of these data by a public office holder and his or her supporting organisation, we will ensure the protection of all data processed about you in accordance with the guarantees laid down in the GDPR for the processing of special categories of data.

The general purpose of the joint data controllers is to maintain political contact with supporters, activists and donors who voluntarily register in a documented manner for the purposes and means set out in this privacy notice, and to inform newsletter subscribers. The specific purpose of political contact is to invite you to events, send you messages via newsletter, messenger, other messaging apps, telephone about voting, the Mayor's agenda, initiatives and events related to his or her political activities. The purpose of the joint data controllers is to solicit and record the views of registered supporters on initiatives related to the Mayor's political activities and to solicit and record the views of registered supporters on fundraising initiatives in support of political activities.

**3.1.1. Individuals registering as volunteers**

<b>The data processed</b>	<b>Aim of data procession</b>
Name (first and last name) (required)	Identification of the registering individual, data must be provided when filling in the registration form
Email address (required)	To contact the registered individual for the general purposes set out in point 3.1 and to achieve activity, this information is mandatory when filling in the form
Phone number (required)	To contact the registrant private individual for the purposes set out in point 3.1, and in particular to provide regular information on the Mayor's events and programme and to achieve activity, this information is mandatory when filling in the form
Post code (required)	Identification of the post code of the individual for the purpose of contacting them with direct updates and tasks, this information is mandatory when filling in the form
Address (street name and house number) (required)	Identification of the place of residence of the individual at the street and house number level for the purpose of contacting with direct updates and tasks, this information is mandatory when filling in the form

**3.2. Legal basis for data processing**

3.2.1 The legal basis for the processing of personal data is that by ticking the box for giving consent when filling in the application form prior to submission and then submitting the form, you consent to the Data Controllers processing the personal data provided on the form for the purposes and under the conditions set out in this Privacy Policy.

3.2.2 If you withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data, the Data Controller will delete all processed data and will no longer store any information relating to you that can be linked to you as a data subject.

**3.3. Duration of data processing**

Your personal data will be processed by the joint controllers until your consent is withdrawn.

#### **4. Access to personal data, data processors**

The Civilek Józsefváros Association and András Pikó will not make the processed data available to third parties in any form without your express prior consent.

The following persons have access to your personal data processed by the joint controllers:

- András Pikó.
- members and volunteers of the Civilek Józsefvárosért Association who carry out data recording and contact management tasks related to the campaign.

In the course of these activities, the data controller uses the volunteers it has commissioned as data processors, with whom it has concluded a confidentiality agreement.

The joint controllers, their representatives, members and volunteers may process the personal data processed only for the purposes set out in this privacy statement, and may not make copies or transmit them or give third parties access to the data processed.

By agreement between the joint controllers, the processing will take place on the Action Network platform. Action Network (1900 L St NW, Suite 900, Washington DC 20036) is a data processor, its processing activities include the provision of technical and IT support, IT services and database management. #### **5. Security measures**

Access to the data processed is granted to the chief administrators and members and employees of the joint controllers with recording and contact functions, as well as to volunteers with processing functions.

The processing of personal data shall be carried out exclusively online, using electronic means and shall not be downloaded, printed, transmitted, copied or recorded by the joint controllers or processors.

Any device used by one of the joint controllers or by any processor shall be protected by a secure password not known to others.

Any incident that affects or may affect the data processed shall be reported by the joint controllers and the processors to the President of the Civilians for Józsefváros Association without delay.

#### **6. Rights of the data subject**

##### **6.1. Deletion of data**

You may withdraw your consent to the processing of your data at any time and request the restriction of the use of your data: in this case, Civilek Józsefvárosért Egyesület and András Pikó will delete these data without delay.

You may also request the deletion of your data if you consider the processing to be unlawful, if the processing is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was carried out, or if the data must be deleted pursuant to an EU or Member State legal obligation.

## **6.2. Correction**

In the event of incorrect data recording or changes to your data, you can of course request the rectification of the data processed.

## **6.3. Restriction of data or objection to processing**

In the event of an objection, the data will be deleted unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. An objection may also be accompanied by a request for restriction of processing, i.e. suspension of the use of the data for the purposes for which they were originally intended.

## **6.4. Information on the data processed**

You may at any time request information from the joint controller(s) about which personal data we process, for what purposes and in what way, and request a copy of the personal data we process. We will comply with your requests free of charge.

Your rights of access and use will only be granted after prior identification, precisely in order to protect your data. Therefore, we kindly ask you to notify us of your requests, statements and complaints regarding data processing by sending an e-mail to [pikotpolgarmesternek@gmail.com](mailto:pikotpolgarmesternek@gmail.com) from your registered e-mail address by filling in the registration form, or, if for any reason this would not be possible, to the President of Civilek Józsefváros, as the person designated by the joint controllers to contact the data subjects, at the above e-mail address or telephone number. In the latter case, proof of your identity will be required to exercise your rights.

## **7. Complaints, remedies**

If your personal data is unlawfully processed or your rights related to your right to information self-determination are infringed, you may file a complaint with the Metropolitan Court of Budapest (1055 Budapest, Markó u. 27., Postal address: 1363 Bp., Pf. 16.) or the competent court of your place of residence or habitual abode, or you may contact the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa u-9-11., [www.naih.hu](http://www.naih.hu)).
